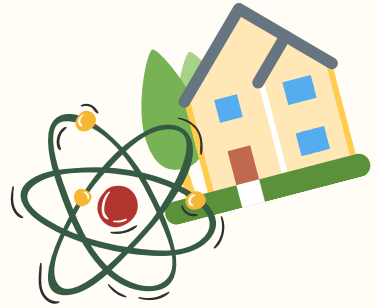

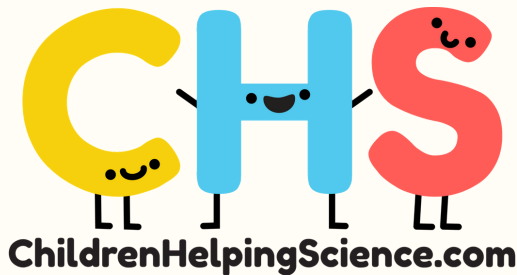
Samia will continue working towards her dream of becoming a pediatrician. In the future, she hopes to care for children and families in underserved areas.
